## Barcelona 'Wine Experience'

**Barcelona** is the land of Modernism and Gaudí. It hosts a Mediterranean sea port and the headquarters of FC Barcelona. Its streets were loved by Picasso and Miró, and it boasts a paradise of tapas and cuisine combined with art, fusion, tradition and modernity.



This is also a land of wines. Barcelona is surrounded by 11 wine regions with denomination of origin. One of these know as Priorat is a Quality D. O. A rating that Spain only awards to one other wine region: Rioja. Discovering Priorat means delving into a world of exquisite taste and exceptional sensations.

## A trip itinerary packed with wine and history

**Day 1: Arrival to Barcelona and transfer to 5-star GL Luxury hotel**, free hours to get to know Barcelona.

**Day 2: Visit to the historical centre -Ciutat Vella-** and Barcelona's Roman and medieval past. Route through the bourgeois Eixample neighbourhood of the 19th century to discover the work of Gaudí and other important modernist architects.

**Day 3: Montjuïc and La Ribera.** Looks for the mark of great artists like Picasso and Miró, and also an itinerary remembering the Olympic Games of 1992.

**Day 4: Parc Güell, Sagrada Família and Camp Nou Stadium.** Three winning aces. Three great monuments that best define the city of Barcelona.



**Day 5: Transfer to the Priorat region.** Visit to diverse wine producers. Wine tasting at some cellars while enjoying the artistic heritage of the so-called “Catedrals del vi” (Cathedrals of wine) designed by Cèsar Martinell, one of Gaudí’s disciples.

**Day 6: Visit to the village of Siurana** perched on the heights of Montsant. One of the most beautiful inland spots in Catalonia. **Tasting of the rural and gastronomic tradition known as a “calçotada” (spring onion festival). Wine and oil tasting in Priorat cellars.**

**Day 7: Route through vineyards and wine cellars in diverse towns of Priorat**, biodynamic and organic wines. Old vineyards, contact with leading winemakers .

**Day 8: Return to Barcelona**, and return to country of origin.
